In March of this year, before the crisis of Covid-19 occurred we were privileged to have a Ladies Tea Party. We invited our mothers and spouses, Solus Christus Ministry and members from Velma McCloud's church who was our guest speaker. It was well attended by almost sixty women.

As I looked around the room, I was struck by the beauty of the women who were so diverse, not only in skin color but also in the experience of life. Some were or had been prodigals in addiction, sex trafficking, or prostitution. Some were mothers of addicts, or those in prison. Some were involved in ministry in their own churches and beyond and had never experienced the pain of a mother's journey. But the most beautiful thing was that we were all mixed together in one room fellowshipping with one another and worshipping our Lord in song regardless of where we came from or what our skin color was. She could have remained bitter and unforgiving, but she allowed God to work in her heart as she chose to love out of her own pain. She shared how everyone in attendance could experience God's unconditional love and share the same with others of different experiences.
